Jörg-Matthias Roche is Professor of German as a Foreign Language at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München, Director of the digital language learning platform Deutsch-Uni Online (DUO), and Director of the International Centre Chamisso (IFC) for the Study of Intercultural Literature. His research areas include language acquisition, multilingualism, intercultural communication, languages for special and scientific purposes, as well as language education and pedagogy.

His current R&D projects focus on task-based learning in various environments, the establishmend of a cognitive framework of language pedagogy inspired by cognitive linguistics, the development of an innovative language assessment method using serious-games and natural language processing technology, the development of a language test for foreign medical staff, the development of quality assurance frameworks for language teaching and the training of teaching staff as well as the professional training and education of refugees in Germany.
